Bob **BULLOCK**: Lt Governor of Texas who organized a full scale renovation and restoration project of the cemetery in 1994.

Edward **BURLESON**: first person buried in the Texas State Cemetery **CEMETERY**: Area of land set aside and maintained as a burial place for the dead

**CENOTAPH**: a monument to someone buried elsewhere,

**EPITAPH**: Short saying or poem carved on the headstone

**GRAVE**: Area of ground where a person is buried, including the headstone and footstone

**HEADSTONE**: Marker, often made of carved stone or metal, placed at the head of a grave to identify who is buried there.

**MONUMENT**: Grave marker that is usually large and stands upright **SYMBOL**: Design, letter, picture, object, etc. that stands for something else **TOMB**: Above-ground structure where family members are buried together
